The ***Aya Symposium*** is a multidisciplinary exploration of freedom colonies in Texas, as well as other Black settlements founded by formerly enslaved members of the African diaspora throughout the United States and the world. Beginning in 2015 (despite initially being held in a sparsely populated corner of Deep East Texas), this one-day event has featured renowned speakers and presenters from across the nation and Texas, including *The Jemima Code* author and James Beard Award winner, Toni Tipton-Martin, and Texas Monthly Food Editor, Pat Sharpe. Once focused on foodways-centered presentations, the symposium has evolved to fully explore the histories, social foundations, and people associated with the more than 500 freedom colonies in Texas – and the future of those colonies.

In 2019, the ***Aya Symposium*** moved to the campus of Prairie View A&M University featuring renowned speakers such as *Dr. Peniel E. Joseph*, founding director of the Center for the Study of Race and Democracy at the University of Texas at Austin and *Dr. Andrea Roberts*, Assistant Professor of Urban Planning and Associate Director of the Center for Housing and Urban Development at Texas A&M University. After a 2020 hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the symposium returned in 2021, reaching a broader audience of teachers, historians, genealogists and history enthusiasts from across the nation in a virtual format. Highlights of the 2022 program on May 19 at Texas Discovery Gardens in Dallas will include Keynote Speaker, *Dr. Daina Ramey Berry*, Professor and Chair of the History Department at the University of Texas at Austin.
